Parents can drop off their children on Thursday July 9, 2009, just before high tide (10:00 am) and return for them on Sunday 12th after high noon. In addition to learning about oldest trophy in history (*predating the Modern Olympics by 45 years!*), we will teach safe boating skills, good sportsmanship, knots, and racing techniques. The children will be under supervision at all times both on and off the water.

There will be on the water instruction of groups for the different sailing levels. We'll be using the Sunfish for the beginners and intermediates and Laser for the advanced group with the opportunity for all to sail some of the larger local boats.
